
## CHIEF OPERATING OFFICER

Before that Manriquez worked for SRO and the Housing Authority of the City of Los Angeles (HACLA). In those roles, both as Director, he oversaw a variety of programs including public housing, tax credit, multifamily and elderly housing, and scattered sites, among others. In the five years preceding those positions he worked for Goldrich & Kest as Director of Property Management and in the Los Angeles office of the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

Mr. Manriquez has managed and directed property management departments in the public sector as well as in the private sector, for profit and non-profit organizations. He has overseen portfolios of over 18,000 units, managed over 450 employees and worked with annual budgets up to \$56M. He has implemented sound capital improvement programs throughout the various portfolios he has managed. He is a hands-on leader that focuses on providing the best overall housing experience to residents at a very efficient cost. Providing quality housing for residents is the driving force that guides the decision making for the properties for which he has held responsibility.
