EHV Basics

- The American Rescue Plan (ARP) of 2021, appropriated \$5 billion for new EHVs
- EHVs are tenant-based rental assistance...HCVs
- Turnover EHVs sunset after September 2023
- Some administrative fees are incentivized and pro-rated based on leasing speed
- •\$3,500 per voucher for eligible services



EHV Award Process

PIH Notice – May 5 Preliminary Award of 504 EHVs – May 10

OHA Award Acceptance – May 14 Final EHV Award Notification – June 10

515 EHVs July 1



Who is Eligible?

EHV eligibility is limited to individuals and families who are:

- 1. Homeless
- 2. At-risk of homelessness
- 3. Fleeing or attempting to flee domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, stalking, or human trafficking; or
- 4. Recently homeless, as determined by HUD, and for whom providing rental assistance will prevent the family's homelessness or having high risk of housing instability



HUD Requirements

- •Partnerships and MOU with the Continuum of Care (CoC) and other organizations for direct referrals, services, and administration of the EHVs deadline for MOU is 7/31/2021
- •All referrals for EHVs must come through the CoC's Coordinated Entry (CE) System or from a Victims Services Provider
- CoCs are responsible for determining applicant eligibility and priority

Unique Conditions

- 1. Covid-19 Waivers apply
- 2. Separate waiting list for EHVs referrals/applicants
- 3. Local Preferences established by the PHA for HCV admissions do not apply to EHVs
- 4. Minimum criminal background screening of meth production and sex offender status
- Modified income and citizenship verification requirements

- 6. Pre-inspection of HQS units
- 7. Initial Search Term 120 days
- 8. Initial Lease Term can be less than 12 months
- 9. Portability no restrictions, can port immediately
- 10. Payment Standard Amount can go up to 120%

Workflow & program guide / VMS data testing June 15-30, 2021

Landlords contacted for preinspections July 15, 2021 Monthly meetings on referrals with County partners

- Staff will outreach to owners and EHV referral families using conventional and new, customized outreach methods
- Designated an exclusive EHV team to assist applicants, participants, and owners

OHA provided:

- New Landlord bonus
- Bonus for re-leasing/HAP renewal
