Eligibility for an affordable unit is determined by HUD and OHA guidelines for resident selection. Your income and asset information will be verified through third parties to determine the household's combined annual income in accordance with HUD Public Housing Program requirements. The eligibility guidelines require that the head of household be 62 years or older.
